IMO Precision Controls continually checks with all suppliers of both raw materials and finished goods to ensure that materials specified under the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC) and Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSI) Conflict Materials requirements are not introduced into our products or manufacturing processes and as such, the below declaration is provided based upon reasonable enquiries and our current knowledge based upon the information provided.
